

There is / are

THERE IS / ARE

THERE IS

THERE IS is used with singular nouns.

- ***There is*** a banana on the kitchen table.
- ***There is*** some sugar in the kitchen.



- **There is** a TV in the living room.
- **There is** a bookcase.
- **There is** a window.

THERE ARE

THERE ARE is used with plural nouns.

- **There are** five bananas on the kitchen table.
- **There are** two dogs in the garden.



- **There are** three CDs on the floor.
- **There are** a lot of books in the book case.
- **There are** two pictures on the wall.

Negative sentences

- ◉ There **is not** a fan in the room
- ◉ There **are not** two pencils in the box.

Is not = isn't

are not = aren't

- ◉ There **isn't** a rose in the vase.
- ◉ There **aren't** books on the desk.



We use:

There was Countable nouns (Singular)
Uncountable nouns

Apple, tomato

sugar, rice

There were Countable nouns (Plural)

Apples, tomatoes

Negative sentences

- There **was not** a carnival last week.
- There **were not** two boys in the classroom Yesterday.

Was not = wasn't were not = weren't


There **wasn't** a drama yesterday.

1. There will be a party on Friday.
2. There will be 25 people at the meeting.
3. There will be a book fair next week.

Negative sentences

- ⦿ There **will not be** a party
- ⦿ There **will not be** computers in the classrooms next year.

Will not = won't

- ⦿ There **won't** be a lecture on “Technology”
