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Present Perfect Tense

Present perfect tense is used to:

talk about an action that occurred at an indefinite point of time.

Sentence pattern

have / has + Past Participle



Ways of forming past participle

1) Regular verbs / "ed" verbs.



2) Irregular verbs



Notice how the past participle used

> I have finished my work.

> She <u>has done</u> her homework.

Negative form:

I have not finished my work.

She <u>has not done</u> her homework.

Question form:

Have you done your work?

> <u>Has she taken her medicine?</u>
