How to use apostrophe?

1. Apostrophe to show the omission of letters

I am Senuja. <u>I' m</u> Senuja.





We are friends. <u>We' re friends</u>.

2. Apostrophe to show possession/ ownership





Sachiru's cap

Nipuni's umbrella

We use apostrophe to,

1) Show the omission of a letter (contraction) positive

I am – I'm You are - You're He is - He's She is - She' s It is - It's We are - We're Who is – Who's Here is - Here's Let us - Let's That is - That's There is - There's They are - They're

Show the <u>omission of a letter</u> (contraction) – <u>negative + Question</u>

- Are not Aren't
- Is not Isn't
- Do not Don't
- Should not Shouldn't

Show the omission of letters (contraction) - positive

I have –I've I will- I'll I would- I'd

Show the omission of letters (contraction)- negative + Question

- Will not Won't
- Can not Can't

2) Show possession/ ownership
