




- What are adjectives ?


The order of the adjectives

Often we can use more than one adjective to describe something. Even four or more adjectives can be used although this is quite rare.

When you use more than one adjective, they are usually in a **particular order.**

ORDER OF ADJECTIVES





Number	describes the number of nouns	one, two, three, four
Opinion	describes your judgement or what you think about something	ugly, horrible, beautiful, fantastic
Size	describes how big or small something is	huge, tiny, long, tall
Age	describes how old or young something is	old, new. young, ancient, antique
Shape	describes the shape of something	circular, square, triangular

Colour	describes the colour of something	black, red, pinkish, blue
Origin	describes where the noun is from	Chinese, Italian, American, African
Material	describes what the noun is made of	wooden, leather, plastic, metallic
Purpose	describes where the noun is used for	fishing, sleeping cooking, sports






