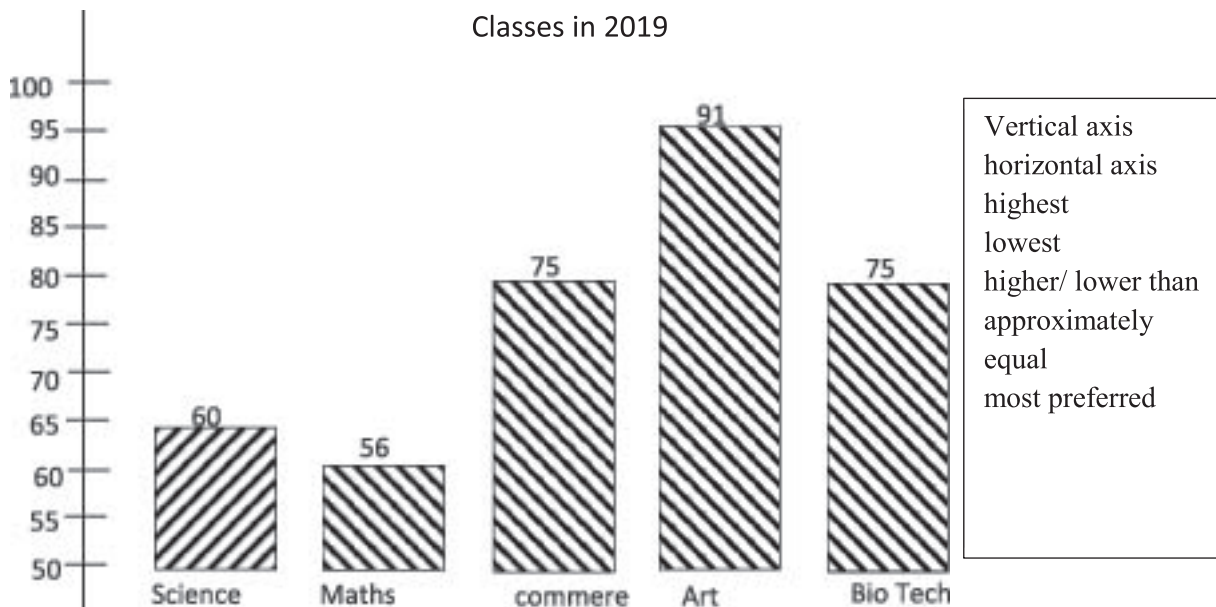

Ronnie was accused of forging the boy's signature and cashing the postal order. A woman identified Ronnie as the boy who had cashed it, and a handwriting specialist also identified the signature as his.
- b. The head teacher refused to listen to Ronnie's side of the story, so the poor boy was sent home to his family. His parents believed that their son was innocent and they backed him up. They wanted a public trial to prove Ronnie's innocence, but the school did not agree to this. Mr. Winslow and Catherine, Ronnie's sister, fought the school.
