Hope you have recollected your memory on “Modal Verbs”.

Some important points to remember when using Modal Verbs:

- Use the basic form or infinitive of the main verbs **after the modal verbs**.

eg: She can play , He must go

- Modal verbs do not add “s” or “es” to the third person singular.
- Modal verbs don’t need auxiliaries to form negative and question

eg: She should stay. ✓ She doesn’t should ✗ stay

- Modal verbs don’t have infinitives or “-ing” form

eg:- canning ✗ to might ✗
