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Let's focus our attention to "Type 1 Conditional Sentences".

In "Type 1 Conditional Sentences", the second action depends on the first action.

eg: If you study hard, you will pass the exam.

if clause

main clause

- ♣ Remember that you are using Simple Present Tense verbs with "If clause", and Simple Future Tense with "main clause".
