

Competency Level-5.4: Reads and responds to simple poems

We can find following **poetic techniques** in poems.

*Visual imagery- colour /size (golden sun) *Auditory imagery- Sounds that can be heard. (**buzzing bees**)

*Metaphor- **He is a lion.** *Simile - **He is like a lion.** *Rhyming words - **brain : train**
