Question mark

We end a question with a question mark.

Example-1: She goes to post office.

Does she go to post office?

Example-2: They are at home.

Are they at home?

Example-3: He is a student.

Is he a student?

Example-4: Questions start with question word (what, where, when, why, how, who & etc.)

What's your name?

Where do you live?

When is your birthday?

How old are you?

Who is your best friend?

Why are you late?

Full stop

We write full stop

1. to show a sentence has ended.

Example: Gehan is a student.

2. to show that an abbreviation has ended.

Example: This is Mr. Silva.

3. as a decimal point.

Example: We went to the canteen at 10.30 a.m.
