


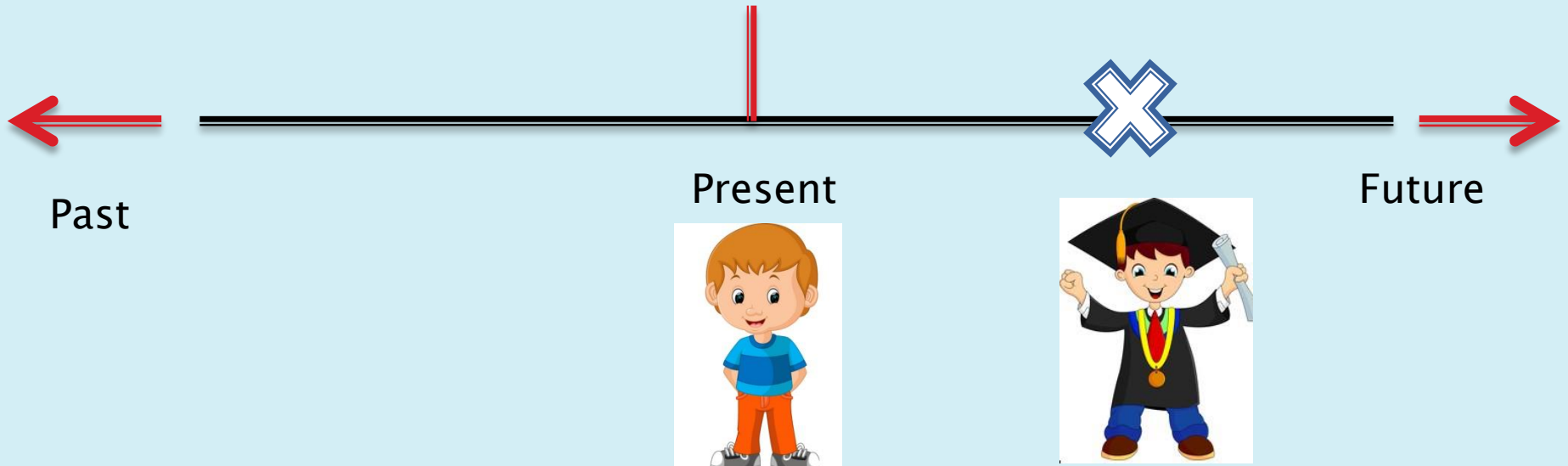
FUTURE PERFECT TENSE

GRADE 10–UNIT 13

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The Future Perfect Tense is used to say that something will be finished by a particular point of time in the future.



I will have
finished my work
by 11 o' clock.



My brother
will have built
a house by
next year.



The train will
have left by 9.15
a.m.



They will have
issued results by
the end of this
week.



Future Perfect Tense is often used with the time expressions such as by five o' clock, by the time you arrive, in two weeks' time, by Friday, before 2025.. etc

Structure of Future Perfect Tense


