Connectives

What are connectives?

A connective is a word that joins one part of a text to another. Basically it joins two separate ideas in two sentences or paragraphs and they usually come at the start of a sentence.

It can be a conjunction, a preposition, or an adverb. For example While, although, even though, though, in spite of, and whenever are some of them.

In spite of

It is used to describe an unexpected situation.

E.g.:- In spite of completing his master's degree, he could not find a quality job.

In spite of John had a good memory, he did not even remember the name of his first teacher.

Although

Although is used to connect phrases, clauses, or sentences. Generally it is used with contrast facts.

E.g.:- I didn't win the game, **although** I tried as hard as I could.

Although she always wears green, she says red is her favorite colour.

Whenever

Whenever means at every time or at any time.

E.g.:- You can go **whenever** you want but never forget to call me.

Whenever my aunt comes to us, she brings some good gifts for my brothers.

While

While means at the same time or at a period of time

E.g.:- While she was waiting ,he poured a cup of coffee.

I often go to sleep while I'm watching television.

Though and Even though

Despite the fact.

E.g.:- I'm going out right now, even though it's raining.

She's still leaving the company, even though they offered her a promotion yesterday.

Though I do not usually drink coffee, I have had two cps today.
