What is an imperative?

An imperative is a command or an order. It can also be used to give instructions, advice or warnings.

Examples :
Sit down
Let's run
Don't shout
Stop writing

We use imperatives to express different functions

Function	Example
Giving orders	Stop running
Prohibiting	Don't smoke
Warning	Be careful
Directing	Turn right
Instructing	Press this button
Inviting	Have a coffee with me
Offering	Take a seat

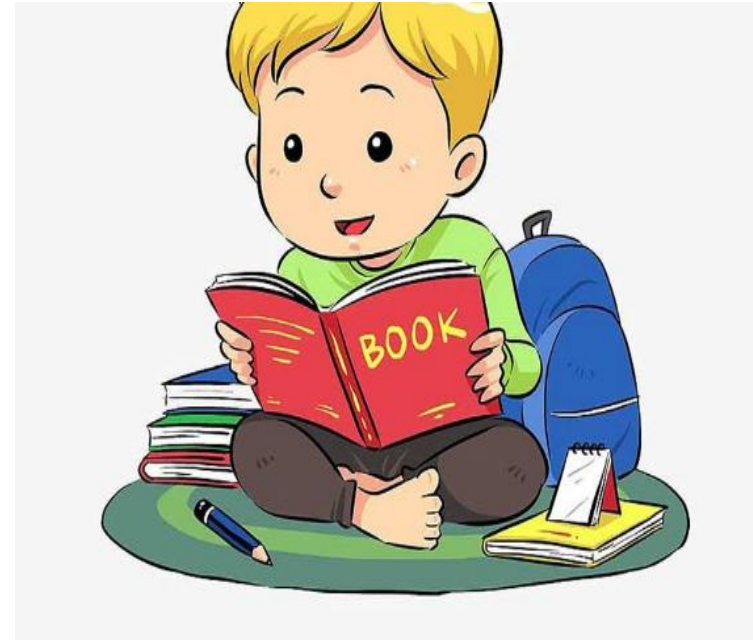
