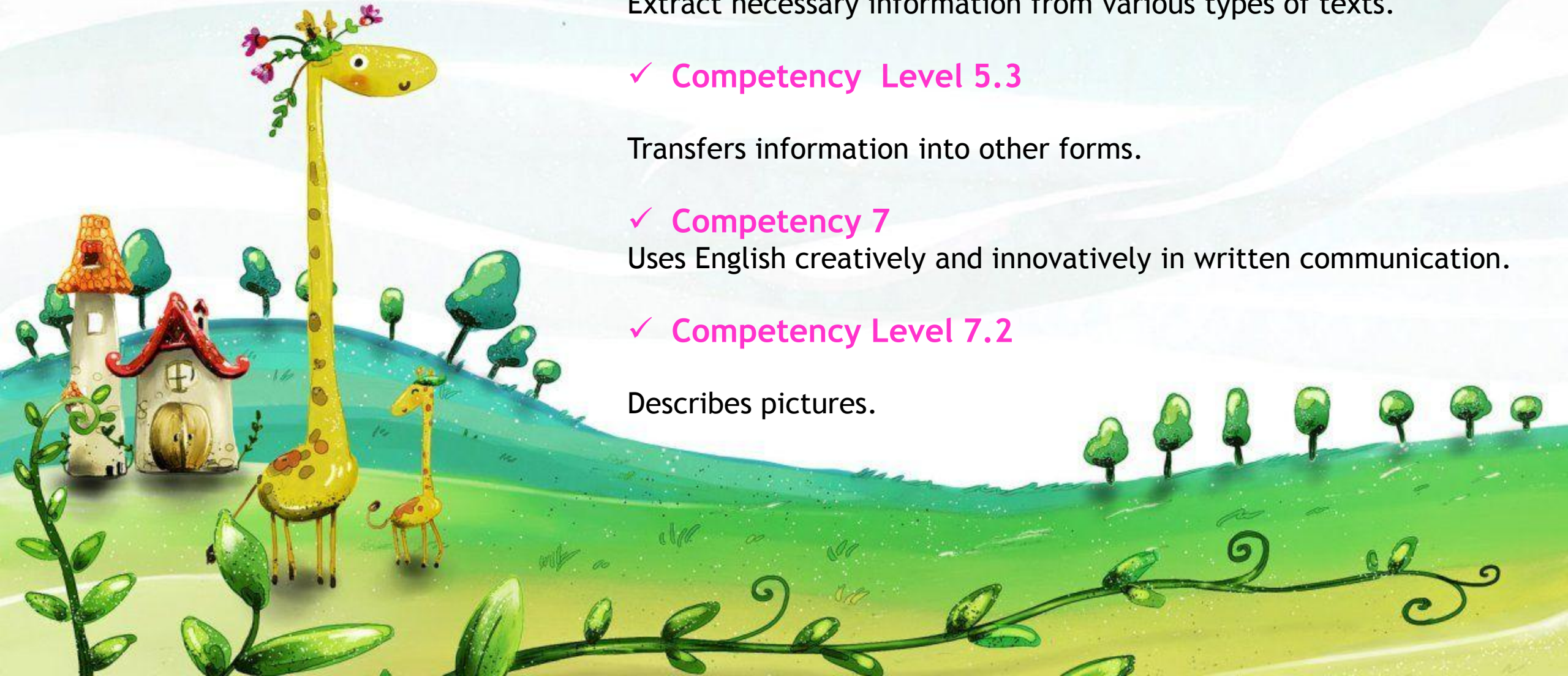

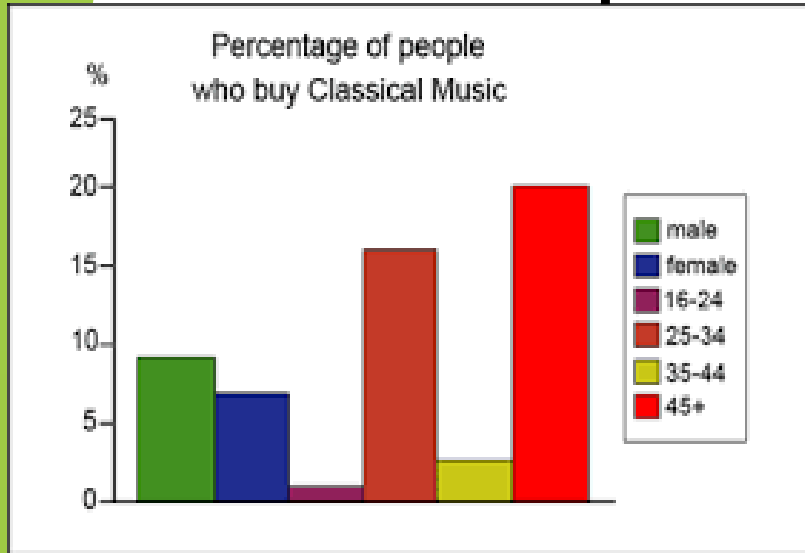

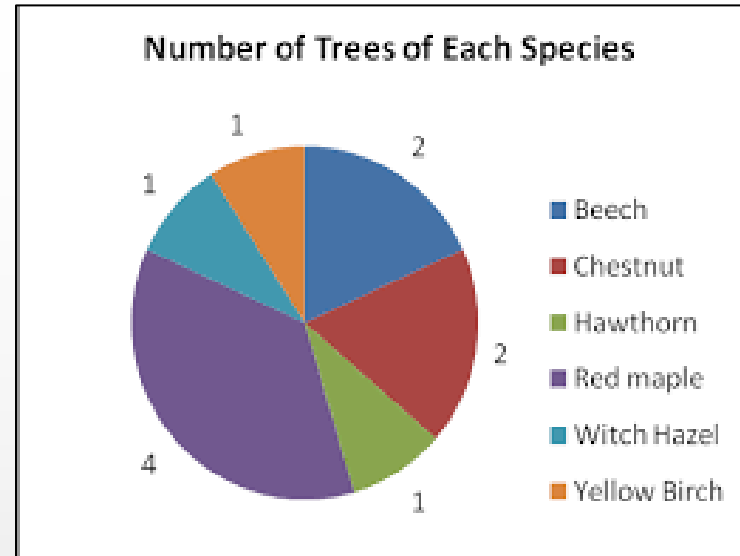


Bar Graph



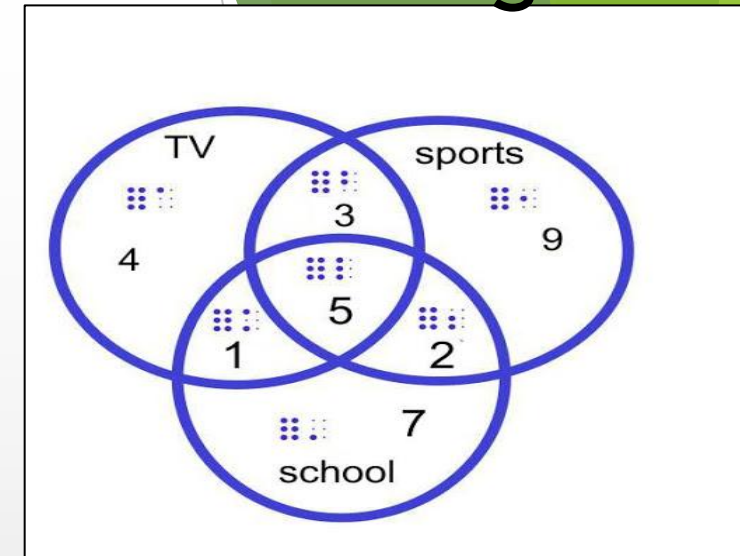
Used to show relationship between different data series that are independent of each other.

Pie Chart



Designed to visualize how a whole is divided into various parts. Each segment of the pie is a particular category within the total data set. It represents a percentage distribution.

Venn Diagram



Used to show all possible logical relations between a finite collection of different sets.

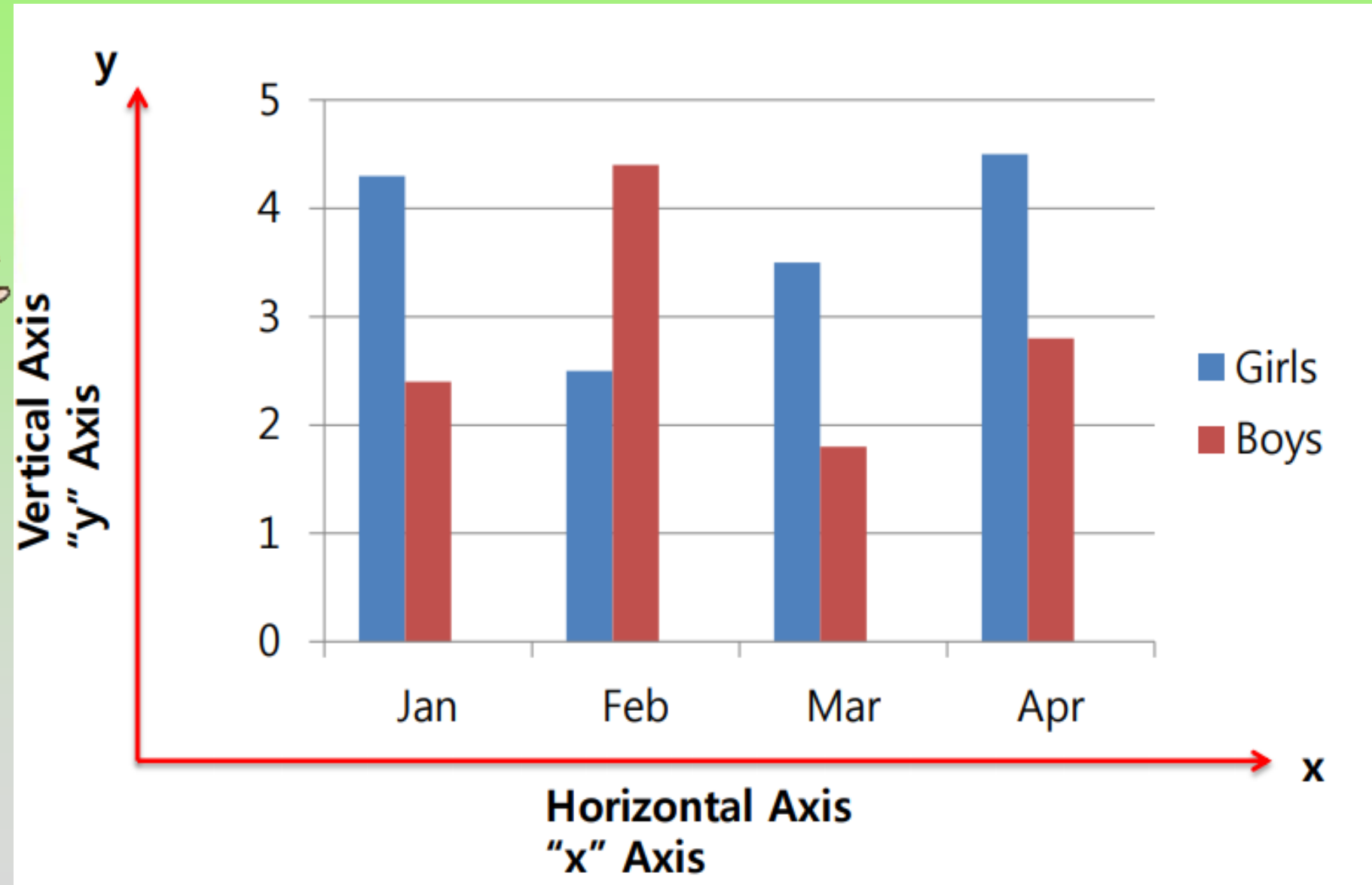
Some tips for writing.....

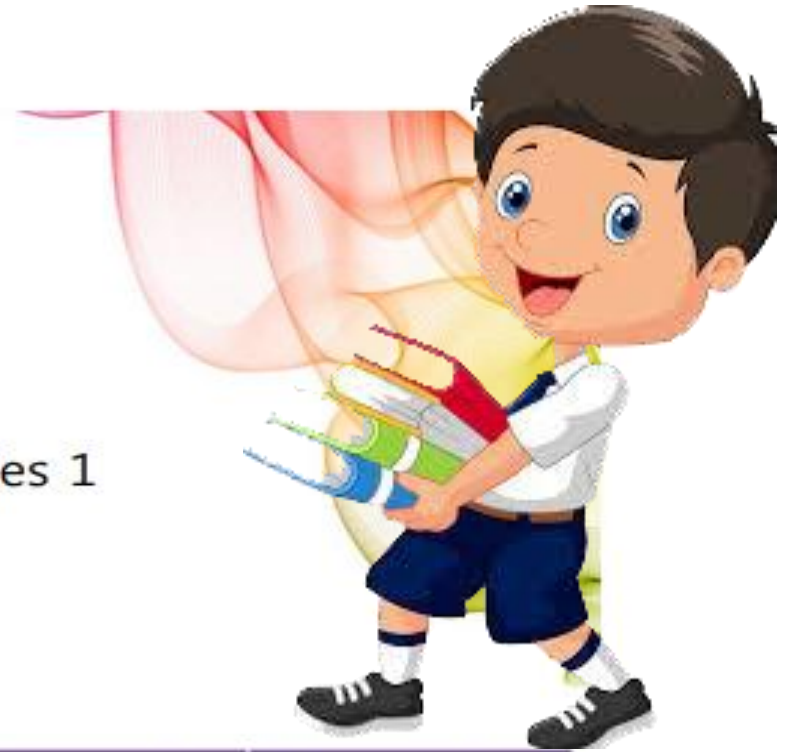
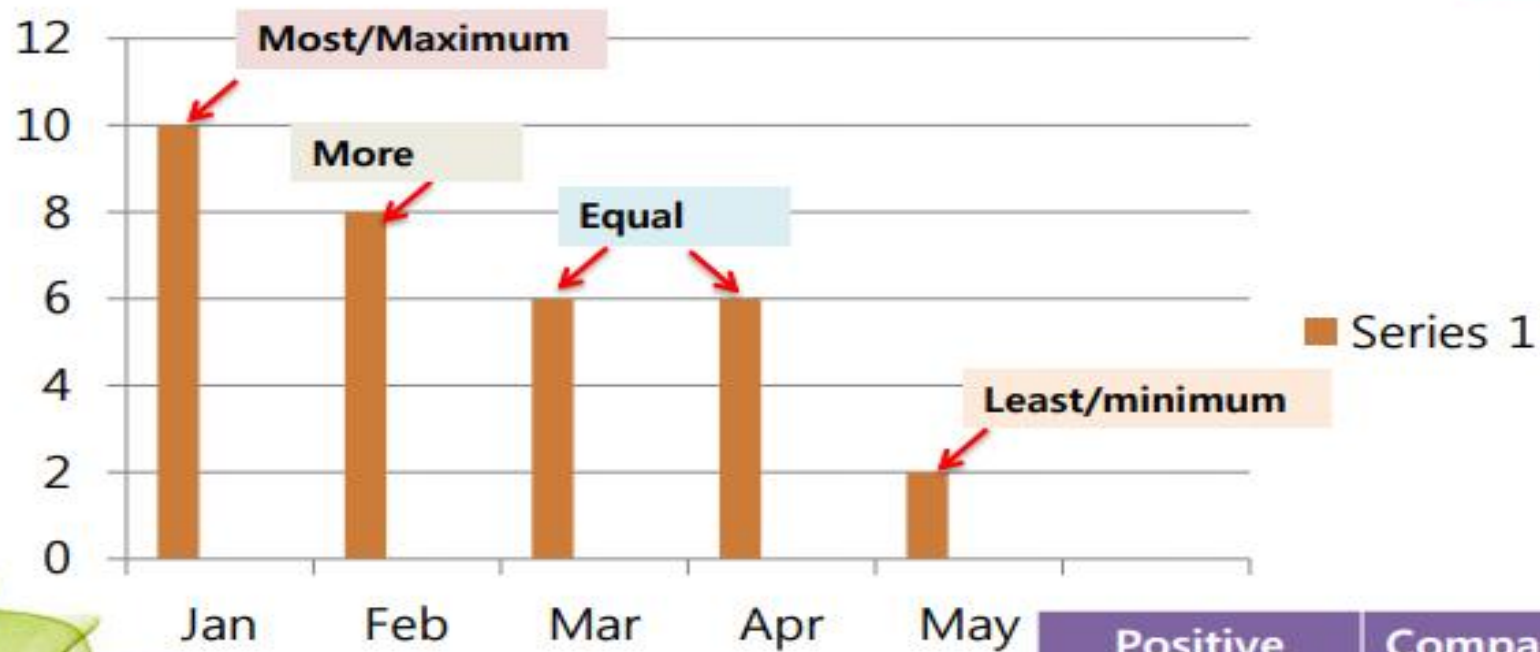
- Start by saying exactly what the chart , graph or the diagram shows.
- Avoid repeating words in the question. Instead, use other words with the same or similar meanings.
- Explain what the different sections refer to and describe the trends you can see.
 - Use data and numbers from the chart.
 - Describe the changes precisely.
 - Compare the information.
 - Talk about differences or similarities.
- To sum up , highlight the most important things the information shows.

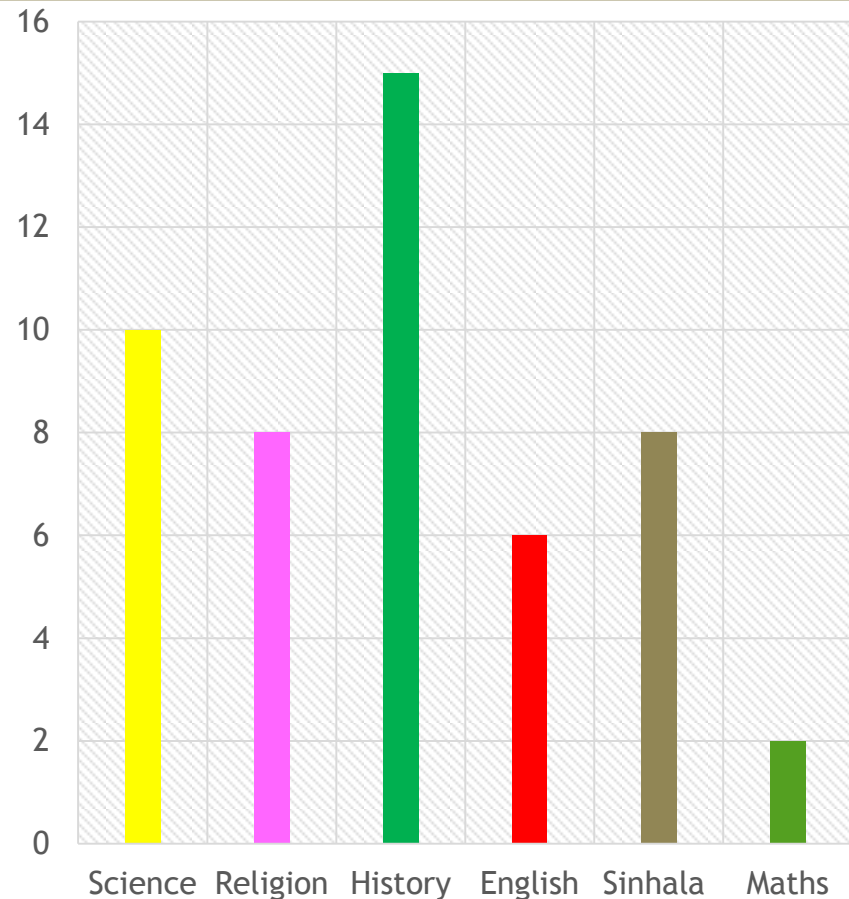

- **A few number of students** like Mathematics.

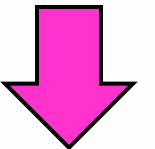
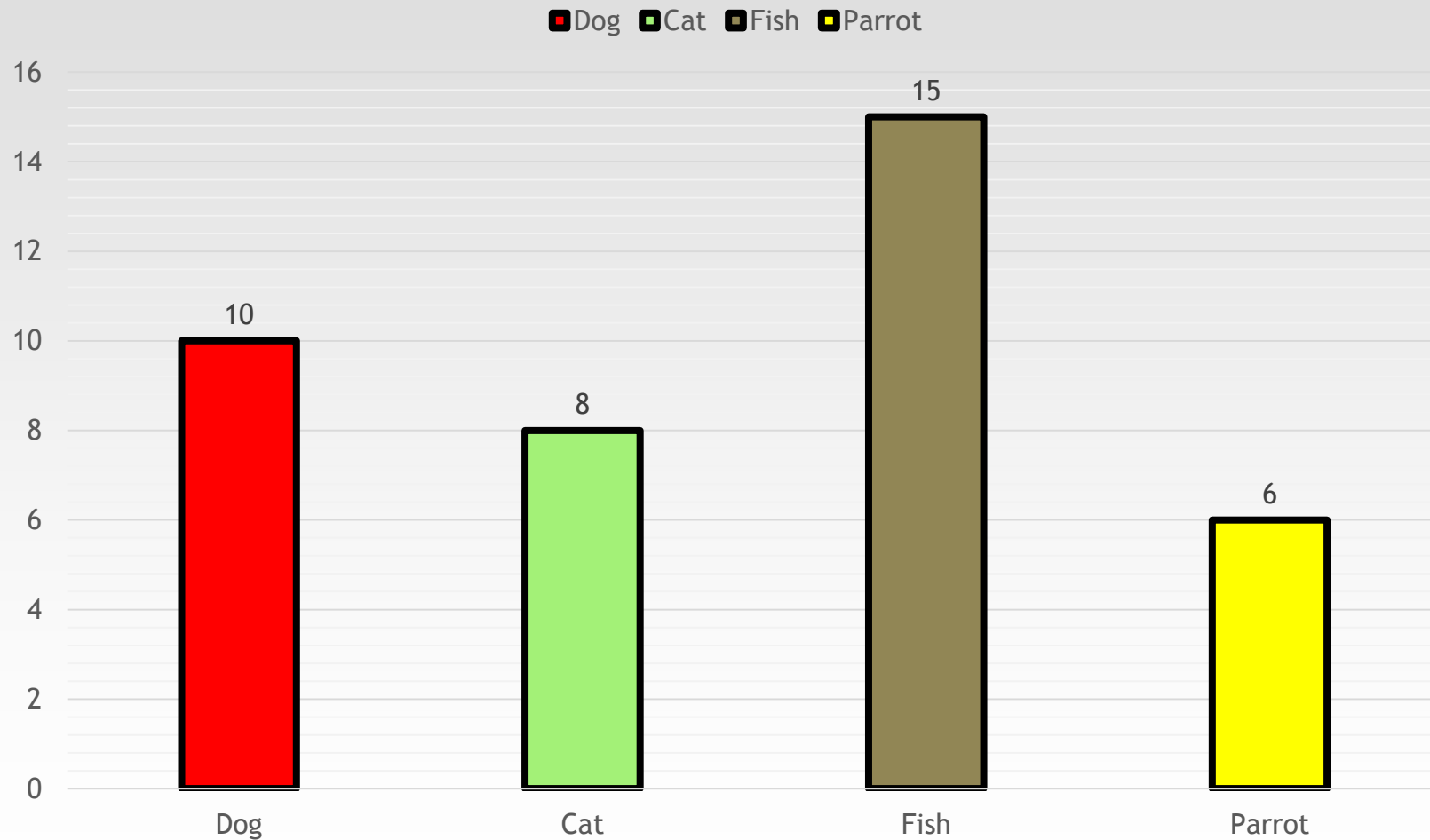

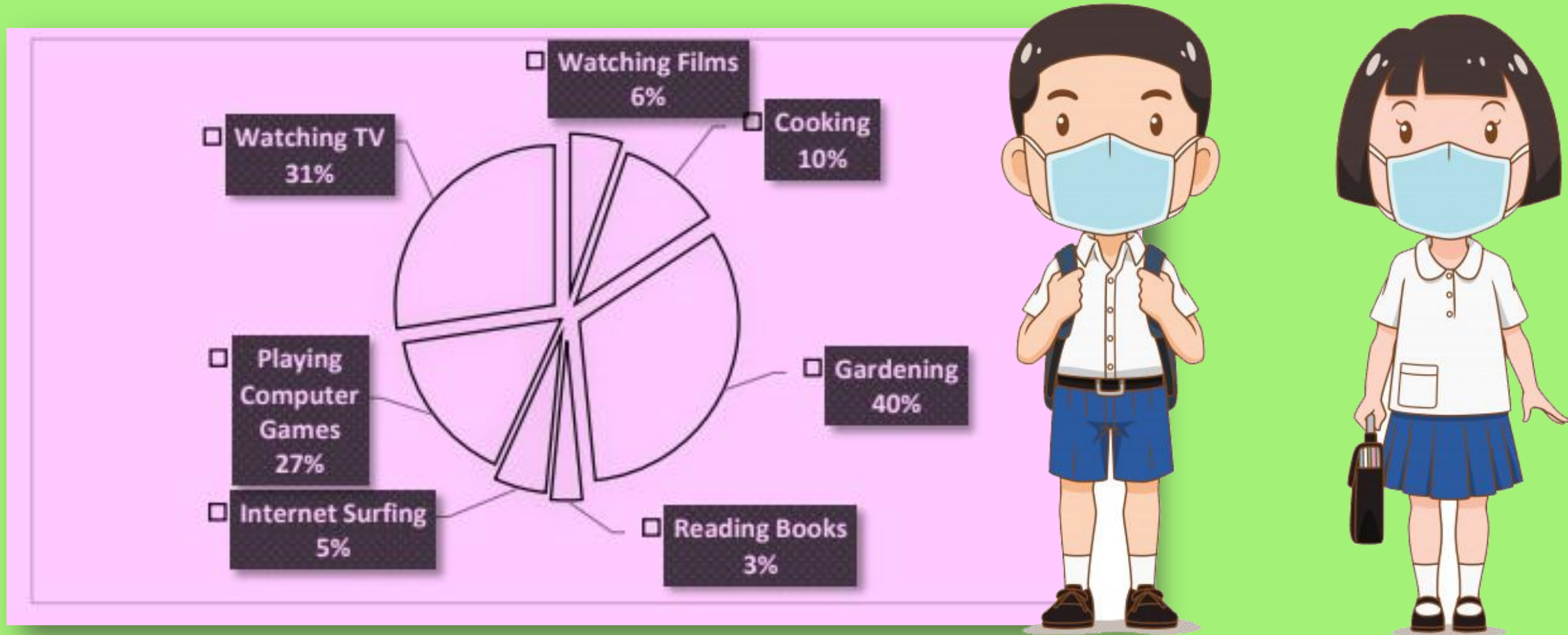

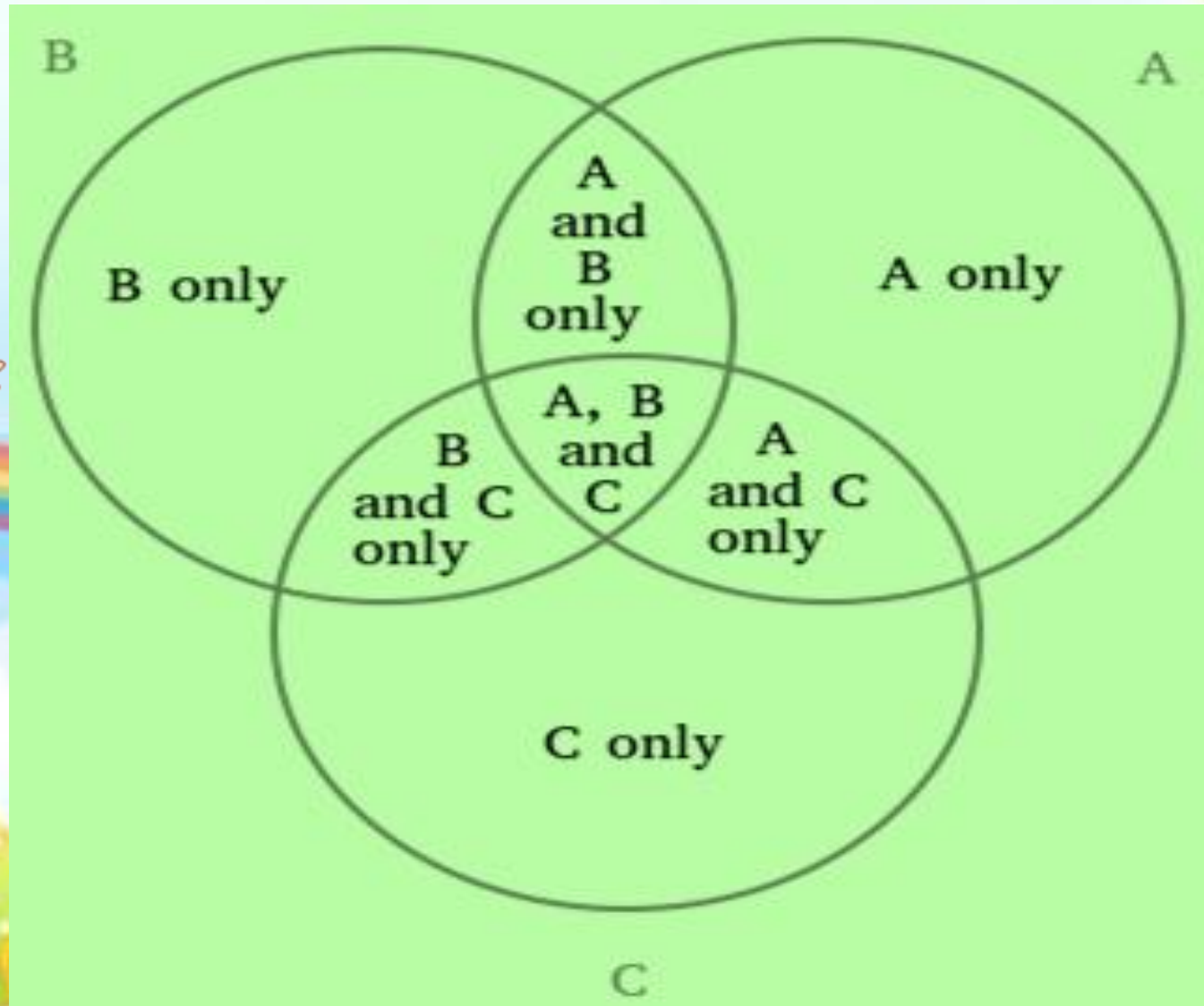

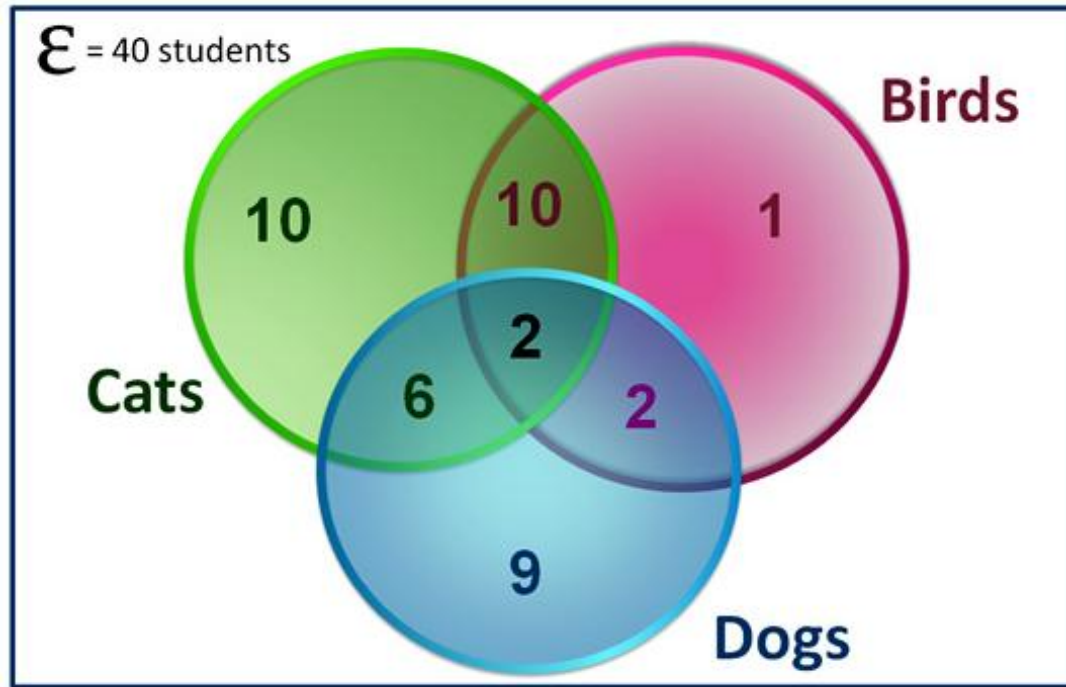

Study the Venn Diagram...

The following Venn diagram shows the different favourite pets of 40 students. Study the diagram and the given description.



The Venn diagram given here shows three favourite pets of 40 students. The pets are birds, dogs and cats.

According to the details given in the Venn diagram, 10 students like **only** cats. 9 students like only dogs **while** only one student likes only birds. **More** children love to have **both** cats and birds. But **less** number students are interested in birds and dogs. Only two students like all these three pets. **As the diagram depicts**, the **majority** of the students like to have cats as their pets and bird is the **least** popular pet **among** them.

Detective stories only ?

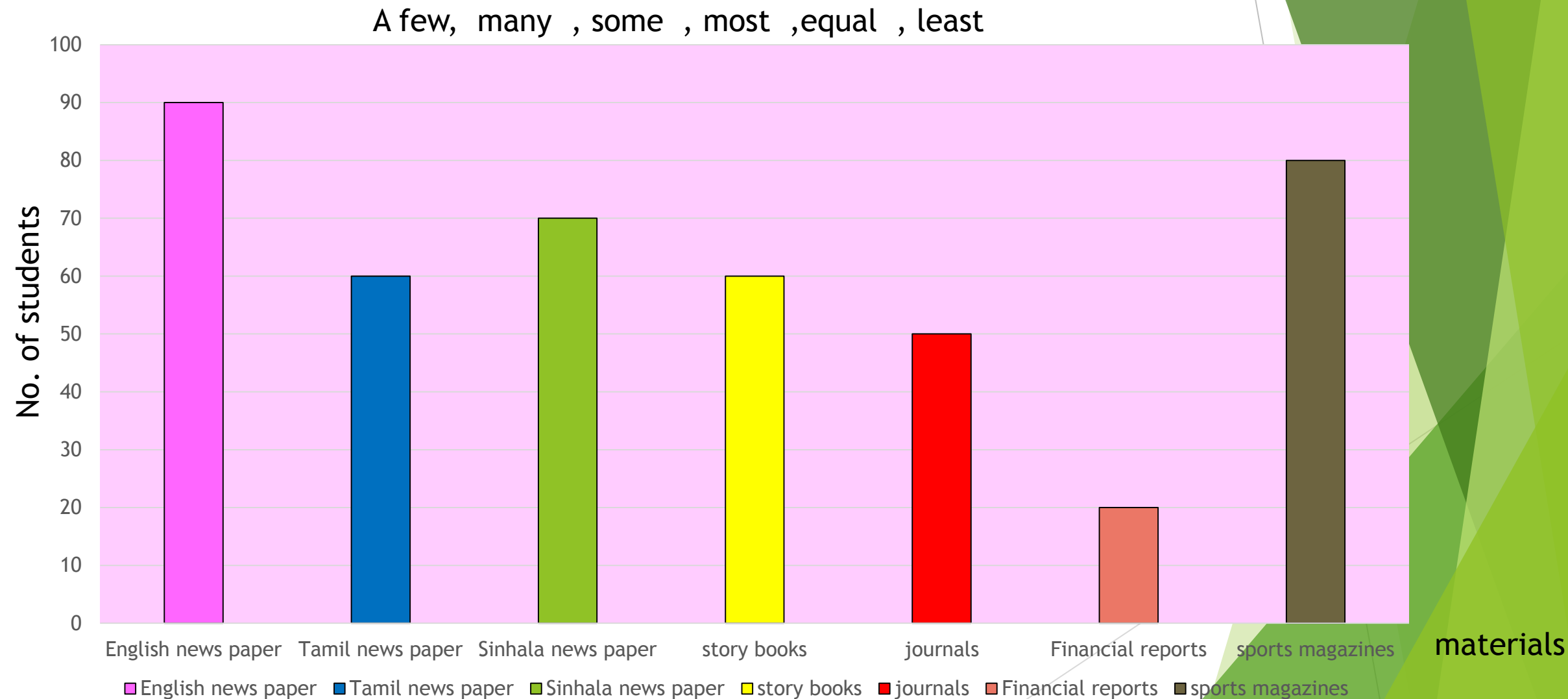

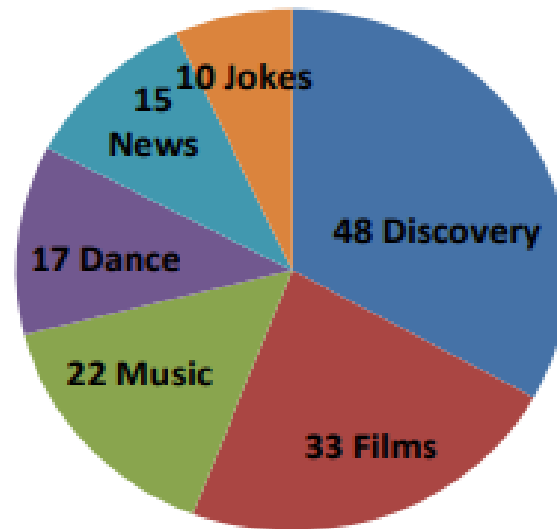

The given pie chart depicts the favourite games of grade 10 students of Hingurana K.V. There are four Games and they are cricket, tennis, football and volleyball.
