
Bar Graph

Used to show all possible logical relations between a finite collection of different sets.


Describing Graphs, Charts & Diagrams.


Some tips for writing....

- Avoid repeating words in the question. Instead, use other words with the same or similar meanings.
- Explain what the different sections refer to and describe the trends you can see.

 Use data and numbers from the chart.
 - Describe the changes precisely.
 - Compare the information.
 - Talk about differences or similarities.
- To sum up, highlight the most important things the information shows.














