




### RECIPROCAL PRONOUNS



• What are Resiprocal Pronouns?

Reciprocal Pronouns are used to express something done by two or more than two people.

Two types of Reciprocal Pronouns are; one another each other



**One another** – It is used to show something (the same thing) done by more than two people

**Each other** – It shows something (the same thing) done by two people.



**One another** refers to more than two people



Each other refers to two people

# Rules of using each other and one another

- Each other / one another are written separately
  Each other and one another do not have plural forms.
  - **Eg**: Kate and Mary helped each other
- 3.) We do not use Resiprocal Pronouns as the subject of a clause.



#### **Each other**





Mary gave a gift to Laura.

Laura gave a gift to Mary.

Mary and Laura gave each other gifts.

#### Sarah is taking to Jane.

#### Jane is talking to Sarah.



#### Sara and Jane are talking to each other.

#### Peter and Mary helped each other.

#### Anne and Tina are talking to each other





**One another** <u>The children</u> shared a pizza with **one another.** 

Here you can see more than two, so you can use the resiprocal pronoun **one another.**

#### More than two
