What is an adverb?
A word that <u>describes</u> or gives more <u>information</u> about a <u>verb</u>.
Examples :

He runs <mark>fast</mark>.



She reads slowly.



Different types of adverbs

Type of adverb	More details	Examples
1.Adverb of manner	Gives us information about how something happens or is done.	Kamal can draw beautifully.
2.Adverb of time	Gives us information about when something happens or is done.	They bought this house recently.
3.Adverb of place	Gives information about where something happens or is done.	You can sit here.
4.Adverb of frequency	Gives information about how often something happens or is done.	They organize an art exhibition annually.
5.Adverb of degree	Gives information about the intensity or degree of a state or action.	She is a very talented dancer.

Characteristics of adverbs

1.Adverbs are mainly formed by adding **"ly**" to the adjective.

Example: Saman is a <u>kind</u> (adjective)boy. He speaks <u>kindly</u>.(adverb)

Adjective	Adverb
sad	sadly
warm	warmly
neat	neatly
slow	slowly
careful	carefully
kind	kindly

2. Some words can be used as adjectives as well as adverbs.

Examples : He is a <u>fast</u> (adjective) runner. He runs <u>fast</u>. (adverb) It was a <u>hard</u>(adjective)work. He works <u>hard</u>. (adverb)

Adjective	Adverb
fast	fast
late	late
hard	hard
early	early

3. Some adverbs are formed by adding "wise" to nouns.

Examples : clockwise

education-wise lengthwise

*He told the children to start moving clockwise around the room.

4. "well" is the adverb of the adjective "good".

*He is a **good** (adj) partner. *He performed **well**(adv) at the discussion.

Position of adverbs

Adverbs can be used in the

1. initial position

Ex: Suddenly, he ran away with a gun. Unexpectedly, he called me after the session. 2.mid position

Ex: The man **slowly** walked out of the room. They have **already** written a project. **3.end position**

Ex: I sent you a message **yesterday.** She addressed the meeting **confidently.**
