COMPOUND NOUNS

Compond nouns are words for people, animals, places, things or ideas made up of two or more words. Sometimes we write them as one word, sometimes as two words and sometimes with a hyphen.

A compound noun is a noun that is made with two or more words.

Examples of one word.

bathroom, windscreen, haircut, toothpaste, lipstick

Examples of hyphens.

check-in, fire-fighter, son-in-law, self-esteem, mother-in-law

• Examples of spaces.

bottle opener, prime minister, rain forest, ice cream

- noun + verb = haircut
- noun + preposition = passer-by
- verb + noun = washing maching
- preposition + noun = underground
- adjective + noun = software
- adjective + verb =
- preposition + verb =
