**La formation**

Le verbe <venir> au présent + de + l'infinitif

Ex- parler  
Je viens de parler  
Tu viens de parler  
Il/elle vient de parler  
Nous venons de parler  
Vous venez de parler  
Ils/Elles viennent de parler

- Elle vient de sortir
- Nous venons d'ouvrir

**L'emploi**

**On emploie le passé récent pour indiquer qu'une action s'est terminée il y a un peu de temps.**

*We use recent past to talk about an action which finished a little while ago.*

Ex : Allô, Madame Legrand est là ? Non, elle **vient de sortir**.  
*Hello, Is Mrs Legrand there? No she just left.*
