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Present Perfect Tense

Present perfect tense is used to:

**talk about an
action that
occurred at an
indefinite
point of time.**

Sentence pattern

have / has + Past Participle

I
We
You
They



have + past participle

He
She
It



has + past participle

Ways of forming past participle

1) Regular verbs / “ed” verbs.

finish	→	add ed	→ finished
play	→	add ed	→ played
cry	→	drop y add ed	→ cooked
stop	→	double p add ed	→ stopped

2) Irregular verbs

eat → eaten

see → seen

be → been

do → done

Notice how the past participle used

- I have finished my work.
- She has done her homework.

Negative form:

- I have not finished my work.
- She has not done her homework.

Question form:

- Have you done your work?
- Has she taken her medicine?
