

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Future Continuous Tense



Future Continuous Tense indicate an action which will be in progress at some definite time in the future.		
POSITIVE (+)	NEGATIVE (-)	QUESTION (?)
I will be starting		Will I be starting
You will be starting	You will not be starting	Will you be starting
He will be starting	He will not be starting	Will he be starting
She will be starting	She will not be starting	Will she be starting
It will be starting	It will not be starting	Will it be starting
We will be starting	We will not be starting	Will we be starting
You will be starting	You will not be starting	Will you be starting
They will be starting	They will not be starting	Will they be starting

Future Continuous Tense

The future continuous tense is formed with will be + the present participle (verb+ing).

We use the Future Continuous to say that an action will be in progress at a particular time in the future.

- e.g.: 1. A: What will you be doing at this time tomorrow?
 - B: I will be doing my homework.
 - 2. When I go home, my little sister will be playing with her doll.
 - 3. Won't you be coming to the cricket match?
 - 4. I hope it won't still be raining when the class finishes.
