Let's study how singular nouns form their plurals



3. When the last letter of a singular noun is **y** and the letter before **y** is a consonant, its plural is formed by changing **y** to **ies**.

Singular (one)

baby

lady

city

fly

Plural (more than one)

babies (last letter - y, consonant - b)

ladies

cities

flies



4. Some nouns ending with **f** or **fe** form their plural by adding **ves**.

Singular (one)

leaf

knife

life

calf

half

Plural (more than one)

leaves

knives

lives

calves

halves



5. Some nouns have **different** singular and plural forms.

Singular (one)

man

woman

child

tooth

foot

mouse

men

women

children

teeth

feet

oxen


