



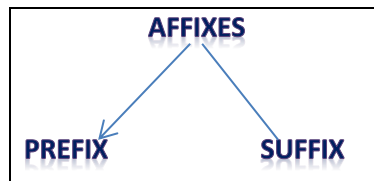

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Affixes



PREFIXES - adding a letter, letters or word to the front.

Eg. Happy - unhappy

tie - untie

SUFFIXES – adding a letter, letters or word to the back of the word

Eg. Kind - kindly

Colour- colourless

By adding affixes, the word class and the meaning of words are changed.

Here are some examples for prefixes

Un, dis, re, in, im, Non, ir, pre

prefix	Word
re	Rewrite
un	Unkind
im	Impolite
dis	Dishonest
pre	Premade
ir	Irregular
non	Nonstop

Here are some examples for suffixes

er, or, ful, ing, tion, ness, ly

Word	Suffix
Teach	er
Sail	Or
Spoon	ful
Paint	Ing
Decorate	tion
Happy	ness
Kind	ly
