- Clauses ¬

A Clause is a group of words containing a subject and a verb and other clause such as object ,complement and adverbial .

1. Subject + Verb

Eg: She runs.

2. Subject + Verb + Object

Eg: He repaired his bicycle.

3. Subject + Verb + Complement

Eg: They look sad.

4. Subject +Verb + Adverbial

Eg: She speaks clearly.

 \neg A Clause may be a complete sentence or a part of a sentence.

Activity I

¬ The incomplete sentences are called Dependent Clause.

¬ The complete sentence is called Independent Clause.

Let's identify the dependent and independent clauses in the sentence

"Whenever I go to the supermarket, I buy an ice cream."

You will notice that the underlined part of the sentence can stand alone as a complete sentence. So it is an Independent clause.

The other part is incomplete, without the underlined part (independent clause). So incomplete sentences are called Dependent clause.
