Do - With plural nouns

Does - With singular nouns

• She cleans her room daily.

Does she **clean** her room daily?

• You drink lots of water.

Do you **drink** lots of water?

Negative Form

We use **Do not / Does not** to make negative form.

Do not - Don't

Does not - Doesn't

• She cleans her room daily.

She **does not clean** her room daily.

You drink lots of water.

You **do not drink** lots of water.
