- **We use it to say that something happens all the time or repeatedly or something is true in general.**
- **It is not important whether the action is happening at the time of speaking.**

Question Form

*We use **Do / Does** to make questions.*

Do - With plural nouns

Does - With singular nouns

- She **cleans** her room daily.

Does she **clean** her room daily?

- You **drink** lots of water.

Do you **drink** lots of water?

Negative Form

*We use **Do not / Does not** to make negative form.*

Do not - Don't

Does not - Doesn't

- She cleans her room daily.

She **does not clean** her room daily.

- You drink lots of water.

You **do not drink** lots of water.
