The structure of the S. V. C. sentence is as follows.

SUBJECT + VERB + COMPLEMENT

The complement here is a subject complement

In S.V.C. sentences, the subject complement can be

a Noun [N], a Noun Phrase [NP], an Adjective [A] or an Adjectival Phrase [AP] :

- i. The characters in the science fiction films are aliens. [N]
- ii. She is a very well known actor. [NP]
- iii. She is beautiful. [A]
- iv. The actor who won the best artiste of the year award is very talented. [AP]
