Helping Verbs

- A <u>helping verb</u> helps another verb to show an action.
- Have and has can be helping verbs.
- Use has when the subject is singular.
- Use have when the subject is plural or I or you.
- Mom <u>has</u> been looking for a new recipe for chocolate cake. Mom and Dad <u>have</u> been married for 8 years.
