Present Continuous Tense

The Form: Subject + am / is / are + “ ing” form of the Verb

Function: 1. To describe action that is taking place now.

Look at the examples.

1. I **am reading** the first sentence now.
2. He **is looking** at me.
3. She **is listening** to the radio.
4. The cat **is drinking** milk.
5. We **are learning** a grammar lesson.
6. You **are sitting** next to me.

Function : 2. To refer to the immediate / planned future events.

Look at the examples.

1. I **am going** to a movie tonight.
2. Ravi **is taking** part in the inter-school drama competition next Monday.
3. Sheela **is going** to the library this evening.
4. We **are visiting** our grandparents this weekend.
5. They **are coming** tomorrow morning.
