• Use the basic form or infinitive of the main verbs after the modal verbs.

eg: She can <u>play</u>, He must <u>go</u>

- Modal verbs do not add "s" or "es" to the third person singular.
- Modal verbs don't need auxiliaries to form negative and question

eg: She should stay. ✓ She doesn't should X stay Modal verbs don't have infinitives or "-ing" form
