### Affirmative contractions

Pronoun	+ to be		+ would	+ will

we	we are	we're	we'd	we'll
they	they are	they're	they'd	they'll
he	he is	he's	he'd	he'll
she	she is	she's	she'd	she'll
it	it is	it's	it'd	it'll
there	there is	there's	there'd	there'll

Verb + not	Contraction
do not	don't
does not	doesn't
did not	didn't
is not	isn't
are not	aren't
was not	wasn't
were not	weren't
has not	hasn't
have not	haven't
had not	hadn't
will not	won't
would not	wouldn't
can not	can't
could not	couldn't
should not	shouldn't
