Countable Nouns/Count Nouns

A count noun is a noun which has a singular and a plural form. It is usually used after a determiner in the singular form.

e.g. :

Singular Plural a books a bus buses

a mango mangoes

How to Form Plural Nouns in English

cat Regular Nouns book friend apple

Add -s

cats books friends apples

Nouns ending in -s, -x, -sh, -ch, -ss bus box dish church dress

Add -es

buses boxes dishes churches dresses

Nouns ending in consonant + -y party
city
candy
baby
anniversary

Change -y to -i Add -es parties
cities
candies
babies
anniversaries

Nouns ending in -f leaf shelf scarf thief calf

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Change -f to -v Add -es leaves shelves scarves thieves calves

Nouns ending in -fe

knife wife life

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Change -fe to -v Add -es knives wives lives
