



During this unit we are going to learn about the conjunctions “since, as and so”.

**Conjunction:** A conjunction is a joining word. We use conjunctions to join two words, phrases or clauses together to make one long sentence.

**Since-** We use “since” to give a reason for something.

Study the following examples

1. I will take the photographs **since** I have a new digital camera.
2. The children played indoors **since** it was raining heavily.

reason

\*Using the conjunction “since” we have expressed a reason.

**As-** as also gives a reason. Study the following examples.

1. I went home early **as** I got a severe headache.
2. My mother baked a delicious cake **as** it was my birthday.

reason

**So-** It also expresses a reason.
