Conjunctions

During this unit we are going to learn about the conjunctions "since, as and so".

Conjunction: A conjunction is a joining word. We use conjunctions to join two words, phrases or clauses together to make one long sentence.

Since- We use "since" to give a reason for something.

Study the following examples

1. I will take the photographs since I have a new digital camera.

2. The children played indoors since it was raining heavily.

\*Using the conjunction "since" we have expressed a reason.

**As**- as also gives a reason. Study the following examples.

- 1. I went home early **as** <u>I got a severe headache</u>.

- 2. My mother baked a delicious cake **as** it was my birthday.
