

To write sentences in <u>Passive Voice – Past Tense</u>, we need



Structure of the sentence.

- ➤ Active voice (subject + verb +object)
- > Passive voice (the new subject + was/were + past participle +by + agent/doer of the action)



Example:

	Active	Passive
positive	Peter wrote a letter.	A letter was written by Peter.
Negative	Peter did not write a letter.	A letter was not written by Peter
Question	Did Peter write a letter?	Was a letter written by Peter?
