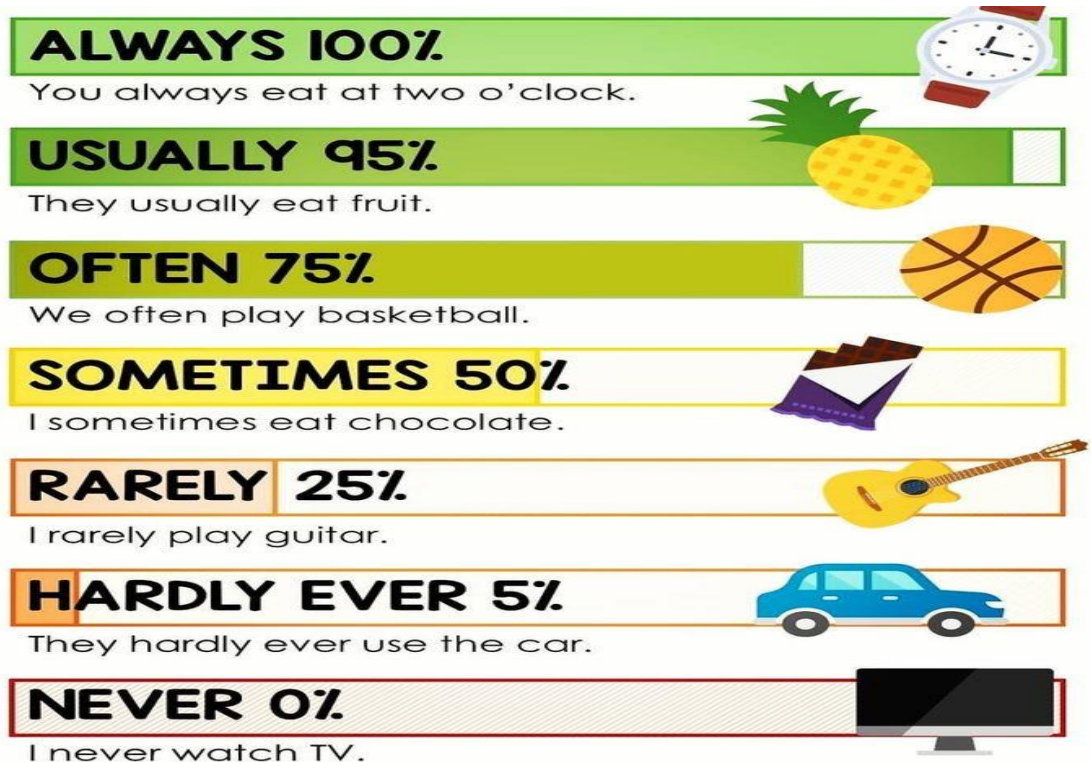
Activity 9.1
