A noun is a person, place or thing.

Ex: Father, Hospital, Table

A verb expresses an action.

Ex: Run, Swim, Prepare

As you know some words in English can be either a noun or a verb. It's important to look at the words go before and after them to identify whether it is a verb or noun.

• Nouns usually come after an article (a, an, the), a preposition (on, in, near...) and possessive adjective (my, her, your...).

I have <u>a pen.</u> Eraser is near <u>the pen.</u> This is <u>my pen.</u>

Verbs are usually come after the subject.

I read books. We can dance.
