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Adverbs

Adverbs add information to a clause. (About the time or place or manner of an action)

Adverbs have many different meanings.

1. **Place – up , there , here , above , upstairs , in ,**
How long have you lived here ?
2. **Time – then , now , soon , recently , afterwards ,**
We arrived only yesterday.
3. **Manner – well , quickly , slowly , hard , fast ,**
Our neighbors greeted us politely.

Ex: We go boating or surfing **during the summer**. (Time) / The swan **swam** in the lake **gracefully**. (Manner) / In Canada, we **spent** three nights **at Hotel Plaza**. (Place)
