

## **Adverbs**

Adverbs add information to a clause. (About the time or place or manner of an action) Adverbs have many different meanings.

- 1. Place up, there, here, above, upstairs, in, How long have you lived here?
- 2. Time then, now, soon, recently, afterwards, We arrived only yesterday.
- 3. Manner well, quickly, slowly, hard, fast, Our neighbors greeted us politely.

**Ex:** We **go** boating or surfing **during the summer**. (Time) / The swan **swam** in the lake **gracefully.** (Manner) / In Canada, we **spent** three nights **at Hotel Plaza.** (Place)
