

## Either .... or / Neither ..... nor

**Either / or :** used in a sentence in the positive sense when we refer to a choice between two possibilities.

Eg: We can *either* read *or* watch television.

**Neither / nor :** used a sentence in the negative sense when we want to say that none of the choices are possible. (not happening)

Eg: *Neither* my sister *nor* my brother is married.

\*( If both elements are singular, then the verb is singular too)

\*( If one of the elements is plural, then we have to use a plural verb)
