SIMPLE RONDO FORM

Many classical movements are in Rondo form. A rondo has a tuneful main theme [A] which returns several times in attention with other themes. Another name for the rondo is Episodically form.

The common rondo patterns are ABACA & ABACABA.

- A Principal theme in music
- B Episode 1 usually in a key on the sharp side of the tonic
- A2 Principal theme in tonic
- C Episode 2 frequently in a key on the flat side
- A1 -Principal theme [complete in tonic with coda]
