SIMPLE RONDO FORM

Many classical movements are in Rondo form. A rondo has a tuneful main theme [A] which returns several times in attention with other themes. Another name for the rondo is Episodically form.

The common rondo patterns are ABACA & ABACABA.

A - Principal theme in music

B - Episode 1 usually in a key on the sharp side of the tonic

A2 - Principal theme in tonic

C - Episode 2 frequently in a key on the flat side
