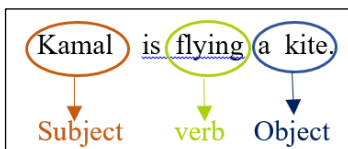

### Present Continuous – Passive form ( Affirmative, Negative and Interrogative)

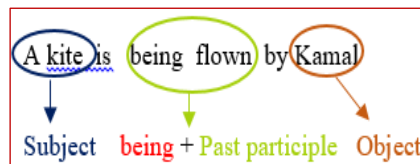
#### Lesson – 01

##### *Present Continuous Passive form – Affirmative*

**Active voice** (Present continuous/ Present Progressive)



**Passive Voice**



**Change into :-**

- Subject → Object
- Object → Subject
- Add "being"
- Verb form → Past Participle
- Subject Pronoun → Object Pronoun

**Subject + be verb + verb (ing) + Object**

**Active voice**

Kamala is cleaning the classroom

**Passive voice**

The classroom is being cleaned by Kamala

**Object + be verb + being + past participle + by subject**

### Present Continuous Passive form – Negative

Active voice

Subject + be verb + not + verb (ing) + object

She is not (isn't) riding a bicycle.  
A bicycle isn't being ridden by her

Passive voice

Subject + be verb + not + being + verb (past participle) + by + object

### Present Continuous Passive form – Interrogative

Active voice

Be verb + subject + verb (ing) + object ?

Is she driving a car ?  
Is a car being driven by her ?

### Passive voice

Be verb + subject + being + verb ( past participle )+ object
