Build

- well built, pump, thin, fat, slim

- > Character traits and emotions
- Humble, Nervous, Honest, Bad tempered, Good tempered, Hardworking, Disobedient Rude, Shy, Energetic, Cheerful, Confident, Positive, Kind, Friendly, Calm, Talkative Funny' Attractive
- > Face
 - Round, Oval, Square, Long
- > (Facial features)
 - Moustache, Beard
- ➤ Hair
 - Long hair, short hair, Bold headed, Curly hair, Blond hair

 - Quick, Fast, Slow, Shift, Speeding, Snappy, Brief, Springy, Bustling, Rushing, Hasty
- **☆** Food
 - Fish, Meat, Leaves, Fruits, Seeds, Insect
- **☆** Parts
 - Shell, Legs, Beak, Tail, Fin, Feathers, Scales, Teeth, Whiskers, Claws, Wings, Arm, Fur, Hornes, Trunk, Ears, Antenna
