How do you express likes and dislikes in French?

A way to express likes and dislikes in French is to use the verb 'aimer,' which means 'to like' and 'n'aimer pas,' which means 'to dislike.

Les expressions:

To ask what someone likes:

Est-ce que tu aimes _____ ? *Do you like?*

To tell what you like, want or prefer

J'aime ... *I like*

J'aime bien... *I really like*

J'adore... *I love*

Je veux... *I want*

Je voudrais... *I would like*

Je préfère... *I prefer*

J'aime mieux... *I like better*

To tell what you do not like or want:

Je déteste... *I hate*

Je n'aime pas *I do not like*

Je ne veux pas *I do not want*

J'aime écouter de la musique.
