Masculine and Feminine Nouns

Grammatical gender is a system of noun classification.

- Masculine nouns are words for men, boys and male animals (Eg: father, landlord, mare)
- Feminine nouns are words for women, girls and female animals (bitch, queen, mother)
- > Thereare nouns which do not fall into both the categories. They are called the gender neutral. (grandchildren, students, people)
