### Conditional Clauses

In the table given below you will see how the all three types of ‘if’ clauses are used.

Type I	Type II	Type III
Condition possible to fulfill	Condition in theory possible to fulfill	Condition not possible to fulfill
if + Simple Present, will-Future	if + Simple Past, would + infinitive	if + Past Perfect, would + have + past participle
Ex: If you invite me for lunch, I will help you with your presentation.	Ex: If we had more employees, we would work more efficiently.	Ex: If I had taken the bus, I would have been late.

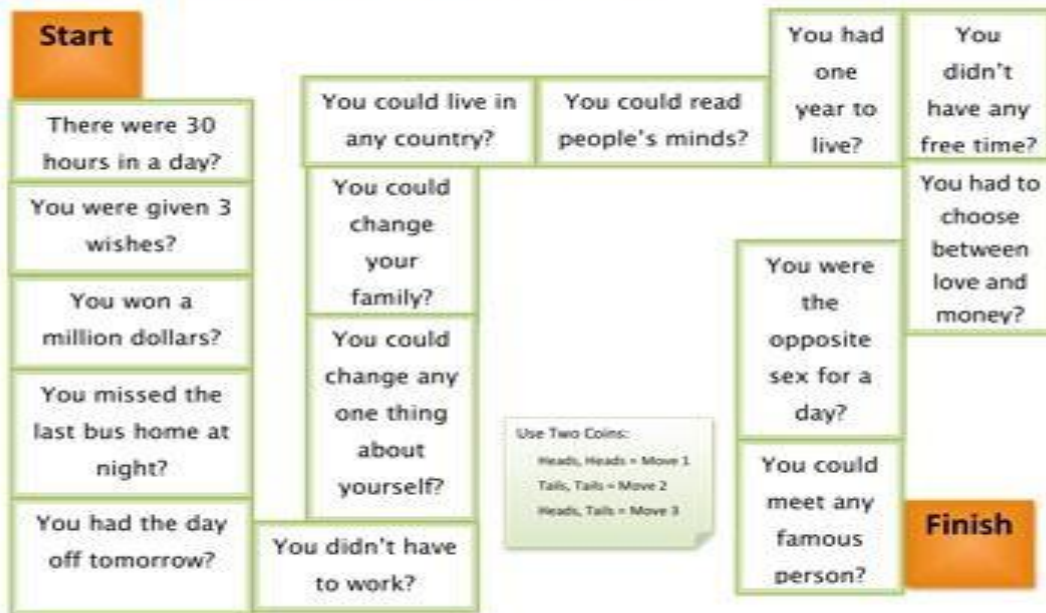
