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Let's learn how to make questions in the past tense. Look at the following examples.

Went = did go

1. Tharun **went** to school yesterday.

Step – 1: Tharun **did go** to school yesterday.

Step – 2: **Did** Tharun **go** to school yesterday?

Wrote = did write

2. He wrote a letter to his uncle.

Step – 1: He **did write** a letter to his uncle.

Step – 2: **Did** he **write** a letter to his uncle?
