

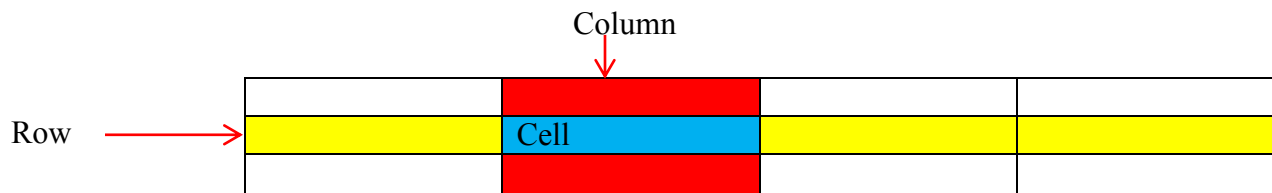


Unit 3 - Word Processing
