To predict future we use ‘Will’ or ‘Will be’

In 50 years’ time....

Affirmative

- There will be farms in the ocean
- People will farm in the ocean.

Interrogative

- Will there be enough food for people ?
- Will people have enough food?

Negative

- Nature will not be able to supply enough food.
- Nature will not(won't) supply enough food.

Will people live on the moon?


