While

The girls were dancing *while* the boys were singing. *While* the boys were singing, the girls were dancing.

Because

The schools are closed *because* of Covid 19 pandemic. We cannot go on holiday, *because* most of the cities are locked down.

But

I tried to hit the nail *but* hit my thumb instead. She couldn't come on time to work *but* she completed it on time.

Or

You can have chocolate ice cream *or* vanilla ice cream. Do you prefer coffee *or* tea?

And

She didn't speak to anyone *and* nobody spoke to her. I have many cows *and* three goats in my farm.

When

He had climbed many mountains *when* he was a boy. *When* I was playing with the children, he came to the park.

After

Many people arrived *after* the chief Minister left. *After* the parents' meeting, I spoke to the principal

Unless

You don't need to go out *unless* it is very important. *Unless* you work hard, you will not get through the exams.

Until

It rained heavily *until* it was very late. The child cried *until* he was his parents.
